By-law to amend Administrative Authority By-law 216-2017, as amended.

To delegate certain powers under the Municipal Act, 2001 relating to the execution of Funding Agreements for the Sport Tourism Hosting Program and to amend By-law 216-2017, as amended

WHEREAS a municipality is authorized to delegate its powers and duties under section 23.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, subject to the restrictions set out in Part II thereof;

AND WHEREAS the Administrative Authority By-law 216-2017, as amended provides for various delegations of authority to officers and employees of The Corporation of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient to provide for additional delegated authority to execute Funding Agreements for the City's Sport Tourism Hosting Program;

AND WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of December 9, 2020, passed Resolution C466-2020 (Recommendation CW317-2020) to authorize staff execution of Funding Agreements and an amendment to Administrative Authority By-law 216,-2017, as amended:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. THAT authority be delegated to the Director of Strategic Communications, Culture and Events to approve the City's funding of individual sport tourism events of \$50,000 or less each and up to a maximum cumulative total in of \$300,000, and to execute on behalf of the City of Brampton Sport Tourism Hosting Program agreements with incorporated non-profit organizations for such approved funding on such terms and conditions acceptable to the Director of Strategic Communications, Culture and Events and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor or designate.
- 2. THAT sections 2 to 20 of By-law 216-2017, as amended shall apply to the delegation authorized pursuant to section 1 hereof, mutatis mutandis.
- 3. THAT Schedule "A" of By-law 216-2017, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following as Activity No. 10(a):
