WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **MUKESH TAKKIAR AND SUPPRIYA TAKKIAR** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot 289, Plan M-817 municipally known as **37 ATKINS CIRCLE**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

- To permit an exterior stairway leading to a below grade entrance in the required interior side yard whereas the by-law does not permit exterior stairways constructed below established grade in the required interior side yard;
- 2. To permit an interior side yard setback of 0.10m (0.33 ft) to the exterior stairway leading to a below grade entrance whereas the by-law requires a minimum interior side yard width of 1.2m (3.97 ft) on one side and 0.9m (2.96 ft) on the other side;
- To permit an existing accessory structure (shed) having a setback of 0.18m (0.60 ft) to the nearest lot line whereas the by-law requires a minimum setback of 0.6m (1.97 ft) to the nearest lot line for an accessory structure.
