7.3 Staff Report re: City-initiated Zoning By-law Amendments

Thank you for the discussion we have had as of late on the proposed City-initiated 'housekeeping' zoning by- law amendments, which are scheduled to be presented at the January 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Planning and Development Committee.

As you are aware, our members raised significant concerns regarding Attachment 3 of the aforementioned report, which contains the City's proposed garage dimensions zoning by-law amendment, along with the proposed transition policy accompanying this amendment.

As a result of these highly constructive discussions, BILD is pleased to note that you will present the following amendments to the Planning and Development Committee on Monday. BILD is supportive of these provisions as they were discussed, outlined as follows:

- 1. That the transition date be July 1, 2024, for any new planning applications submitted. This would "grandfather" all existing approvals and plans currently in the approval process; and
- 2. A workshop with BILD to develop appropriate garage dimensions to meet the City's objectives and to address industry concerns prior to Council adoption of this by-law.

BILD members have consistently valued the cooperative working relationship we've maintained with the City. The effectiveness of our dialogue and open discussions has led us to this mutually workable solution. We look forward to continuing our collaboration with the City on this matter in a solution-oriented manner.
