Nature of Problem: Student Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Concerns at the Intersection of

Earnscliffe Gate and Earnscliffe Circle

Observations:

- 1. At the intersection, Earnscliffe Gate runs north-south, and Earnscliffe Circle runs east-west. Earnscliffe Circle is a through street with a stop sign and crosswalk on Earnscliffe Gate. Earnscliffe Senior Public School is located east of the intersection on Earnscliffe Circle. There is a sidewalk on the north side of Earnscliffe Circle and both sides of Earnscliffe Gate.
- 2. During both site inspection times, approximately 25 students crossed at the crosswalk with no issues.
- 3. During the morning site inspection, many drivers did not come to a complete stop at the stop sign, however, no students were in the intersection at those times. Traffic at the intersection was heavy from all three directions, due to the short length of Earnscliffe Gate, but no major issues were observed. The afternoon traffic was a little lighter and still no issues to report.
- 5. During the site inspections, less than five elementary students crossed from east to west by themselves and without issues. No school related safety concerns were observed.

Recommendations:

- 1. That this Site Inspection report for Earnscliffe be received, and
- 2. That the Manager of Traffic Operations be requested to review the proposal on Earnscliffe Circle to operate as one way street.
