

Notice of Intention to Amend Brampton Procedure By-law Regarding In-Person Participation for Closed Sessions

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its meeting on Wednesday, March 27, 2024, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall, Brampton Council will consider a by-law to amend Procedure By-law 160-2004 to:

- **Limit participation within Closed Sessions of Council, and all standing Committees of Council, to in-person for all Council members and City staff.**

By resolution C292-2023, passed at its meeting on December 6, 2023, Brampton City Council directed staff to prepare and present such a by-law to Council.
