I am a resident of Zone 1 and live at [REDACTED], and am writing to express my deep concerns with the proposed development located at 123-125 Railroad Street.

My concerns are the following:

- Significantly impact of the heritage and character of this historic neighbourhood
- Lack of cohesion with the existing homes and building standards in the area
- Reduced sunlight and privacy for existing structures and homes
- Increased traffic combined with increased environmental noise and congestion
  - Increased congestion at the GO Station track crossing at Mill Street
  - Reduced pedestrian and public transit accessibility
- Reduced road access within the neighborhood and increased construction traffic for the duration of the project
- Concerns regarding existing infrastructure to adequately support an increased demand on these services
