RECOMMENDATIONS:

 That the report from Kevin Minaker, Manager, Traffic Operations and Parking, Road Maintenance, Operations and Fleet to the Committee of Council Meeting of March 20, 2024, re: Time Limit Parking – Ace Drive – RM 75/2023 (Ward 9), be received; and

2. That Traffic By-law 93-93, as amended, be further amended to implement permissive 20 minute parking on the east side of Ace Drive between Docksteader Road and a point 125 metres south of Mayfield Road.

OVERVIEW:

- At the November 1, 2023 Council meeting a report titled "Parking Restrictions – Various Locations – Wards 2 and 9" was approved to implement parking restrictions on Ace Drive in order to resolve traffic safety related concerns.
- The above noted parking restrictions were subsequently installed to resolve the immediate traffic safety concern.
- RM 75/2023 directed staff to explore the possibility of permitting a timerestricted permissive parking zone on Ace Drive between Docksteader Road and Mayfield Road to accommodate temporary parking for trucks accessing local businesses.

BACKGROUND:

At the November 1, 2023 Council meeting a report titled "Parking Restrictions – Various Locations – Wards 2 and 9" was approved to implement parking restrictions on Ace Drive

in order to resolve traffic safety related concerns with the condition staff to report back on the referred matter below.

Referred Matter 75/2023

Explore a time-restricted permissive parking zone on Ace Drive between Docksteader Road and Mayfield Road to accommodate temporary parking for trucks accessing local businesses.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Ace Drive (Ward 9)

Staff investigated allowing time-restricted permissive parking on Ace Drive to assist truck drivers attempting to access local businesses on the southeast corner of Mayfield Road and Ace Drive. Based on the investigation, staff are recommending implementing time-restricted permissive twenty (20) minute parking on the east side of Ace Drive between Docksteader Road and a point 125 metres south of Mayfield Road. This will allow for temporary legal parking for those accessing the local businesses and will encourage frequent turnover of the parking spaces to accommodate more customers.

CORPORATE IMPLICATIONS:

Financial Implications:

The costs associated with the installation of the traffic signs required to support this initiative are estimated to be \$100. There is sufficient funding available within the Public Works and Engineering operating budget to proceed with the recommendations in this report.

STRATEGIC FOCUS AREA:

This report supports Brampton's Transit & Connectivity through the addition of time limit parking on Ace Drive.

CONCLUSION:

This report proposes time-restricted permissive parking restrictions on Ace Drive to provide a temporary location for truck drivers to legally park while accessing local businesses.
