Capital Improvements

- Bus Stops:
 - 2,683 Total
 - 2,320 Accessible (86%)
 - 363 Non-Accessible (14%)
 - Estimate 95% by 2032
- Bus Shelters:
 - 1,007 total shelters
 - 876 Conventional, 131 Züm



Capital Improvements

- 2023 Pad & Shelter Program:
 - 30 non-accessible bus stops were converted to fully accessible bus stops
 - 20 new bus shelters, and 10 replacement bus shelters were installed
- The 2024 Pad & Shelter Program will aim to have a similar number of installations as the 2023 program



Capital Improvements

- Bramalea Transit Terminal has been reconstructed with new concrete, tactile strips and new signage
- The accessible Pick-up & Drop-off area just south of Bramalea Transit Terminal has provided more options for passengers to access Brampton Transit services



2024 Service Plan

- Public Information Centres (PICs) were held earlier in April to gather feedback from residents and riders
- Transit staff are reviewing the feedback to determine what changes can be implemented based on approved budget from Council and availability of resources
