# Our Journey and Mission




#### Relocation

### **Reached Maximum** Capacity

In our 2023/2024 school vear, we have:

- 9 Classrooms
- 98 students in FDK -Grade 8
- 13 high school students



### **Founding of Noon** Academy

2007

- · Began as a small Islamic tutoring program.
- Established a permanent location at 265 Queen St. E. in 2019

### Registered as an **Islamic Private** School

2013

· Opened as a fulltime private Islamic school with 18 students from FDK to Grade 8.

### **Second Expansion**

 Leased additional land behind 8 Rutherford Rd. S.

### Registered as a **Charitable Organization**

2022

 Allows us to receive taxdeductible donations and apply for grants, enabling further expansion of our programs and services.

Plans to expand capacity and services to meet growing community needs, enhancing our community impact.








### **Summary**

- Noon Academy is operating at or above capacity in several areas.
- The classrooms and community hall areas are fully utilized, and elementary enrollment is slightly over capacity. Furthermore, Secondary enrollment is underutilized at 65% capacity due to the inability to expand.
- The annual event congregation significantly exceeds capacity, resulting in the need to rent external halls or revenues to provide these services.
