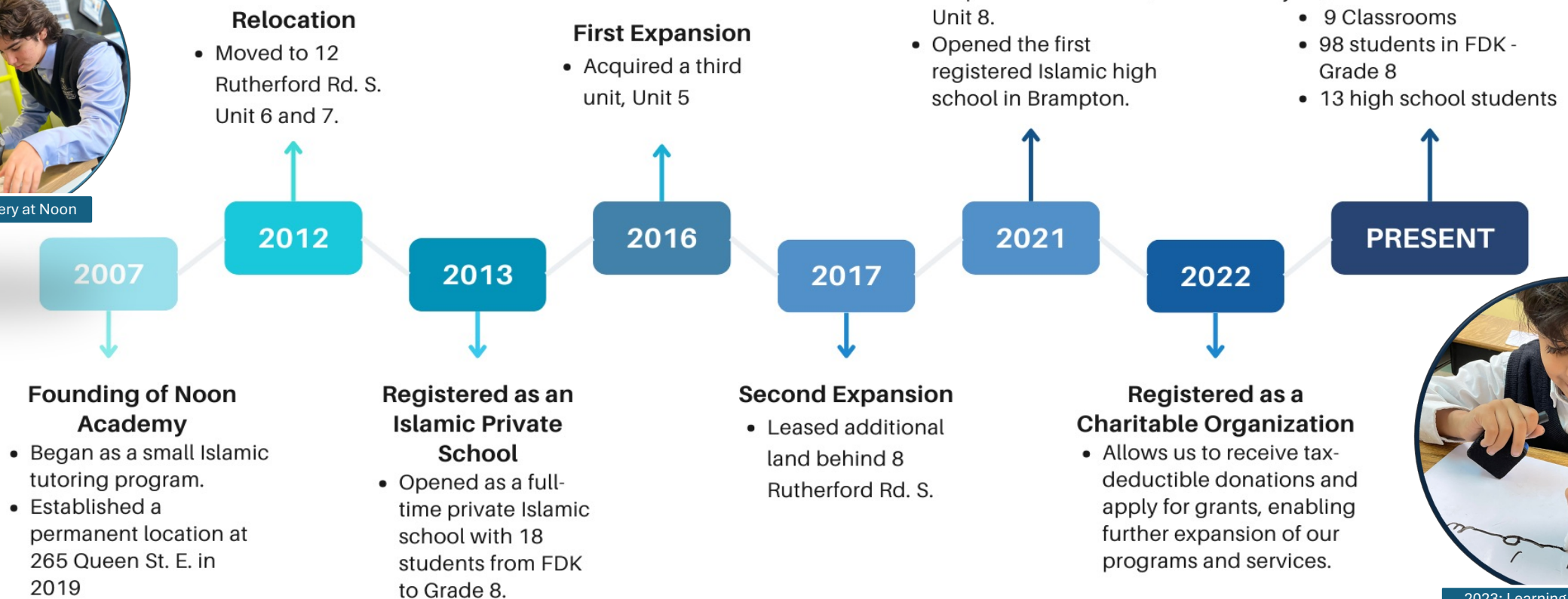

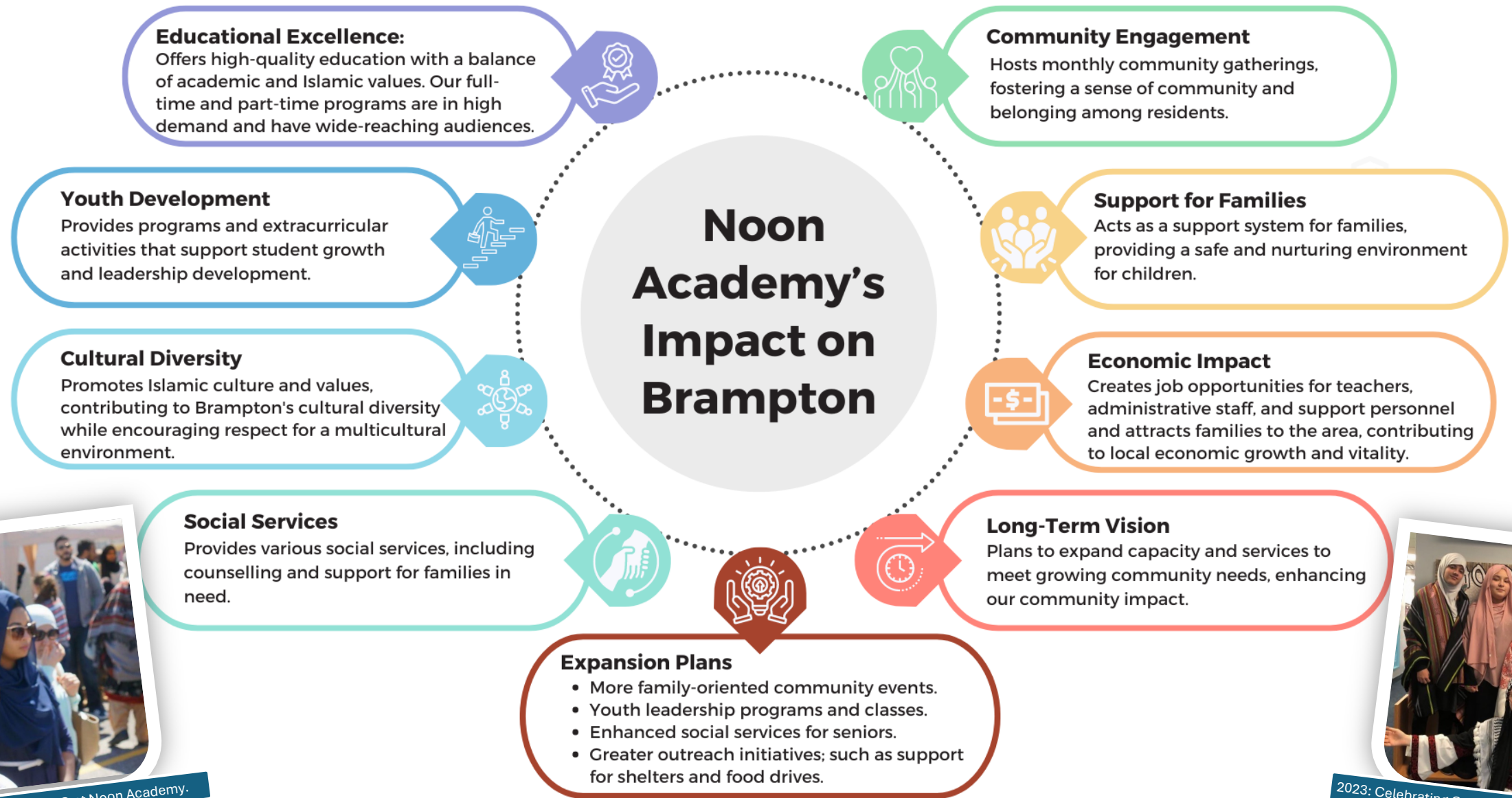

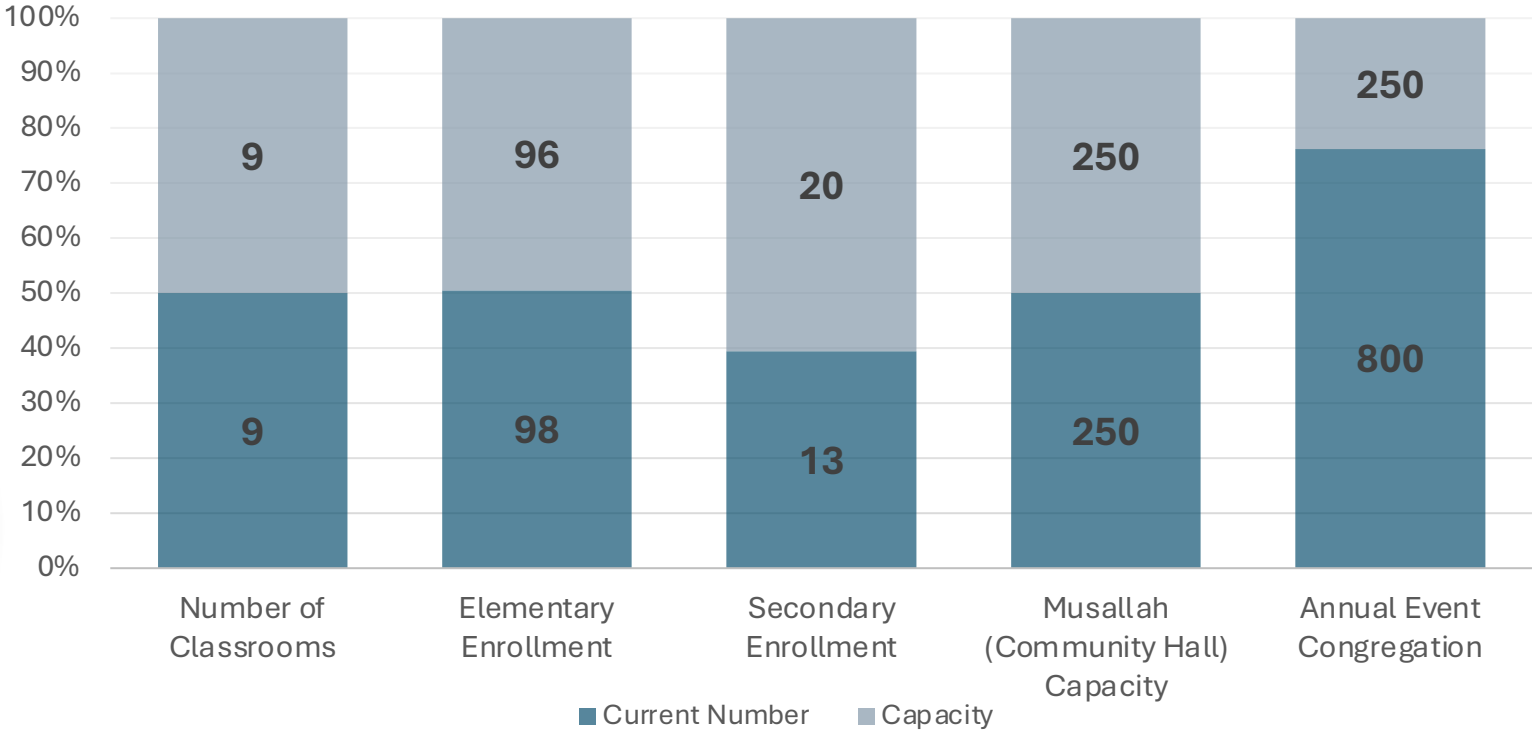
Urgent Needs and Challenges

Summary

- Noon Academy is operating at or above capacity in several areas.
- The classrooms and community hall areas are fully utilized, and elementary enrollment is slightly over capacity. Furthermore, Secondary enrollment is underutilized at 65% capacity due to the inability to expand.
- The annual event congregation significantly exceeds capacity, resulting in the need to rent external halls or revenues to provide these services.



Call to Action

Objective:

Secure a long-term fixed lease at 8 Rutherford Rd. S. for stability and growth.

- A stable location will allow us to focus on program and organizational development.

Vision for the Future:

A permanent location will empower Noon Academy to expand its programs, reaching more residents and fostering a stronger, more inclusive community.
