In response to the invitation to the virtual meeting and to express our concerns about the new infrastructure on Main Street, I must be candid:

- * The plan requires revision, particularly regarding height, in light of the 45-degree angular plane.
- * Additionally, we cannot overlook other zoning, building, and yard considerations.
