I am writing to express my strong opposition to the proposed housing project in our neighbourhood, I believe that this project would have a detrimental impact on our community.

First and foremost, the proposed project is simply too large for our area. The increase in population density would put a strain on our already overburdened infrastructure, leading to increased traffic congestion, noise pollution, and strain on our public services.

There are not enough resources to service people who are living nearby, how high density construction will be served?

Day cares - more than one year waiting, Schools are already to full capacity, No family doctor available in nearby by clinics..

We only have one community center near by gore meadows, when we have to book spot for our kids for any activities - we have to go online at 6 am when spots open, after one hour you cannot find time and day of your choice. In this kind of scenario this kind of proposal i will not be even call as "development" coz this will just pass threshold on already stressed resources and system.

Crime rates are ready at peak, my home insurance has doubled in last 3 years, new quotes for car insurance are exorbitant for this postal code coz of theft and accidents. On top of all, this kind of development will make things worse.

These all are personal experiences I am seeing and it's getting worse.

Additionally, the construction of this project would result in significant environmental damage, destroying natural habitats and putting wildlife at risk.

Furthermore, the type of housing being proposed is simply not in keeping with the character of our neighbourhood. This neighborhood consists of low rise homes which has less density.

This high density high rise apartments will cause imbalance in population and there are not enough resources to support this.

In conclusion, I strongly urge you to reconsider this proposed housing project and I strongly object this , I believe that this project is simply not the right fit for our neighbourhood. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
