


# Resident Concerns

- Opposing re-zoning of the area as mentioned in the application
- This rezoning amendment will increase the number of dwellings resulting in a population increase leading to over crowding (projected from 448 Executive homes to 1089 detached, semi, towns and apartments units)
- This will impact the infrastructure already in place which was only suitable for the executive single family and semis
- Crime will increase (i.e; North of Finch, there were approx. 17.02 crimes for every 1000 people moving into the neighbourhood due to large apartment complexes, resulting in a decline in current property values

# Proposed Green Space

Ownership of the 10-hectare Community Park was transferred to the City of Brampton in 2013

Park will include a ~100,000 square foot Recreation Centre

\$70M budget and anticipated completion date of 2025/2026\*

Amenities (to be determined through design process):

- Aquatics centre
- Fitness centre
- Gymnasium
- Seniors and youth space
- Tennis courts
- Splash pad
- Skate park



# Critical Issues & Neighbourhood Impact

- Builder has misled past buyers and still misleading its current/ prospective home buyers by not disclosing this proposed amendment application pending with city
- Population increase to 2000- 2500 additional people in this area
- Infrastructure is not in place to handle the overload of the population
- Brampton citizens already pay the highest property taxes and auto insurance premiums compared to the rest of the Greater Toronto Area (GTA)

# Decline in Property Values

- Current residents/ homebuyers feel misled by the builder
- It's the Builder's greed for making additional sales volume of approximately \$400+ Million if amendment to rezoning by-law is permitted
- Increase of 2000- 2500+ people in the area will place more pressure on the existing infrastructure (schools, parks, roads etc), resulting in a decline of our current property values for which we all have paid premium prices for our executive homes

## Increased Traffic Flow

- Leads to congestion on the roads, where Mississauga Road is already very busy due to the rise in housing developments in the surrounding areas
- More accidents; safety of residents at risk
- Increase in air pollution
- Increase in auto insurance rates/ premiums

# Over Crowding

- Leads to an increase in Crimes
- Robbery, vandalism, abductions will rise
- Compromising safety of vulnerable people from kids to elderly
- Reduced outdoor amenities/ green spaces

# Conclusion

- We, the residents of this neighbourhood request the governing body/ councillors of the City of Brampton to reject the builder's proposed amendment for re-zoning by-law to build the apartment buildings
- Also, take into consideration the points aforementioned herein
- Expedite construction of hospital, community center & Mississauga - Embelton community park to be operatable by end of 2022
