Upon a first conviction of an offence of the Special Events Bylaw 045-2018 a fine of not less than \$500.00 and not more than \$10,000.00 may be imposed by way of Part III Provincial Offence Prosecution.

City of Brampton Additional Notes

Upon a first conviction of an offence of the Nuisance Bylaw 136-2018 a fine of not less than \$500.00 and not more than \$100,000.00 may be imposed by way of Part III Provincial Offence Prosecution.
