Burnt Elm Public School – Brampton School Traffic Safety Council

There is an excess of vehicles parked on Burnt Elm Drive during drop-off and pick up times causing issues for residents of the street. There are concerns that emergency vehicles would not be able to pass through the street due to the volume of vehicles parked on both sides of the street. This is an ongoing issue over multiple years. The morning rush occurs from 8 am to 8:30 am and the afternoon rush, which is worse than the morning, starts around 2 pm, but the worst of the rush occurs around 2:20 pm to after 2:40 pm when the school is dismissed.
