Delegation to the Committee of Council: Requesting deferral of development charges related to new building for KMSchool, 11499 The Gore Road, Brampton

Introduction: Good morning, esteemed members of the Committee of Council. My name is Harpreet Singh Gill, and I am here on behalf of our multicultural, multifaith private school in Brampton, KMSchool. Our school provides high-quality Montessori education, along with ethnic faith and language programs, catering to the diverse cultural landscape of our city.

Our mission is to create a nurturing, inclusive educational environment where students of all backgrounds can flourish academically, socially, and culturally. This is made possible by providing an authentic Montessori program that includes learning of each child's unque ethnic language and faith.
