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I would like to add this email as a delegation to this Wednesday meeting item # 9.2.3 "Road Resurfacing Procurement".

The city needs to budget \$35 million for Road Resurfacing in the 2025 Budget.

Roads have the ability to resurge a neighbourhood and we need to maximize our efforts to gentrify and resurge neighborhoods.

Many streets in Peel Village, Flowertown, Eldomar, C, G, J sections of Bramalea are in dire need of road resurfacing. Once resurfaced: We will see a rejuvenation of the street, more pride and interest for residents who live there, and attraction to buyers.

I know the city budgeted 25 Million last year, asking for an additional 10 million that will be used for Mature Neighbourhoods specifically.

Streets I ask to be included in the 2025 Road Resurfacing Budget include:

- Bartley Bull Parkway (from Tullamore to Peel Village Parkway).
- Mill St from Elizabeth St S to Elgin.
- McMurphy Avenue from Elgin to Queen St.
- Central Park Drive (from Bramalea Road to Torbram).
- Leander St (entire length).
- Bartley Bull Parkway (from Orchard to Rambler).
- Sterne Avenue (entire length).
- Ambleside Drive.
- Laurelcrest St (Queen to Lorraine).
- Murray St (Williams to Garden).
- Prouse Drive.
