GTHA Carbon Emissions – AT is the good news!


- Unprecedented \$7.7 Billion weather related insured losses across Canada in 2024
- GTHA carbon emissions up by 2% in 2023 (up 1 million tonnes)
- Third straight year of **increases** to pre-pandemic levels
- Meeting 2030 target now requires **11% average annual reductions**
- Largest absolute increase came from **transportation**
- **GTHA sustainable transportation rates increased (transit 28%, walking 7%, cycling 4%)**
