My name is Donna Mazzaferro and I am a home owner and resident in Ward 3. I strongly oppose application A2024-0429 / 4 Alderway Ave to widen the driveway beyond what is allowed per the Brampton bylaw.

This summer, I was one of the many home owners who's home that flood and I'm still dealing with insurance and remediation months later.

Allowing properties to continually widen driveways is clearly leaving our sewer systems unable to catch runoff from all this excessive water. Currently, Brampton's infrastructure seems unable to handle the rate of growth and there are many clear breakdowns in service in many areas down the line. There are repeated requests to halt on ARUs being put forth until the City is able to catch up on these service issues. Councillor Keenan also requested back in April at a Council meeting that we need to halt driveway widening to understand the cumulative effect of all the driveways that have been widened - Steve Ganesh, Commissioner agreed with Councillor Keenn and confirmed the city needs to understand the impact of all the additional hardscape that is out of control.

It would be wise to have all units of government working together on creating a safe and healthy growth of our community. It is a disservice to one department to allow uninhibited allowances without every branch of government being on the same page.
