I think that we should have been given more time to address issues like this, bearing in mind that people work and also at this time of the year weather plays a factor in both getting mail and the ability of being able to respond.

I hope that you will still take what I have to say into consideration, my concern being that some people will not respond due to not being available at such short notice.

I am very much against this; we already have owners renting out their basements (illegal) which is causing overcrowding and to many cars parked in the street, Has the 3 hour parking timely (by-law) changed as it does seem to be enforce anymore.

I have lived here from the beginning (30 yrs) and the **quattroplex unites were meant to be single family units not multi-family units**. By-laws were in place to protect this and to prevent overcrowding. During the winter snowplows cannot clear the street properly because of cars blocking their access and nothing is done about it.

I live with my daughter who is on disability (60 years old) and we find that the by-laws are no longer adhered to, for example, garbage is put out the day before, supposed to be after 7pm the night before. Items not due to be picked up on that day are left lying for the next week and the street ends up looking like a dumping ground.
