We are writing on behalf of the Stellantis Brampton Assembly Plant, located at 2000 Williams Parkway, to express our views regarding the proposed change of use for the property at 2600 North Park Drive, Brampton. As this site is directly adjacent to our manufacturing operations, any modifications to its use could have implications to our plant and workforce.

Stellantis, together with local suppliers, has played a vital role in supporting the automotive sector, a cornerstone of Canada's economy. Historically, many of the properties surrounding the Stellantis facility have housed key suppliers that are integral to our production supply chain. Preserving adequate employment lands in this area is therefore essential to maintaining the industrial and manufacturing activities that support our operations.

We respectfully urge the Committee of Adjustment to uphold employment-focused land use policies that protect Brampton's manufacturing ecosystem and strengthen its role as a leader in advanced manufacturing.
