




# Total Families we Intake in the Past 2 Years




Total Women taken in

# WCP Shelter Intake

- ▶ 2022-2024, most of our families are transitions from Victims services (Safe Centre of Peel)... about 50% of the families that comes to us and 38% are from the community. Now, in total we have taken in 8 families including children from SCP.
