To Amendment to By-law 257-2020, the Execution of Documents by Electronic Signature.docx

WHEREAS Section 15 of the *Electronic Commerce Act, 2000,* S.O. 2000, c. 17 provides that if a public body has power to create, collect, receive, store, transfer, distribute, publish or otherwise deal with information and documents, it has power to do so electronically, including the signing of documents by electronic methods;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted [Resolution #] to Amendment to By-law 257-2020, the Execution of Documents by Electronic Signature.docx to remove the monetary limitation requirement for the execution of documents by electronic signatures;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 257-2020 is hereby amended by deleting Section 4 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
 - "4. The following Documents may NOT be executed by Electronic Signature pursuant to this By-law:
 - cheques, bank drafts, orders for payment of money, promissory notes, acceptances, bills of exchange, debentures and any similar instruments; and
 - b. any Document the Execution of which by Electronic means is prohibited by law."
