

Brampton's first-ever Community Safety Action Plan


• Developed 25 actions under 3 priorities: Safety | Awareness | Empowerment

- Conducted **54 neighbourhood visits** from 2018-2022
- Engaged over 3000 residents with for input in-person neighbourhood walks, workshops, and virtual tours
- Received input and feedback from 2800+ completed resident surveys and mapping tool comments

Outcomes:


- Residents gain access to municipal staff through CSWO

- Residents have increased opportunities to participate and connect within the community





2025 Affiliated Neighbourhood Associations

- 34 Affiliated Neighbourhood Associations received more than \$61k in Nurtured Neighbourhood Grant funding (first intake)
 - o Up to \$2,000 for returning group and up to \$1,500 for new groups
- Projects: movie nights, litter cleanups, barbeques, street parties, fitness events, etc.
- Two intake periods March 2025 and June 2025
