

**Issue Background:**

The recent amendment to By-law 8b-2025 unfairly restricts residents from parking on their own private property. If a resident has a proper hard surface designed to support vehicles (such as concrete, asphalt, or interlock) and parking there does not block sidewalks, roads, or neighbors' access, there is no reasonable justification to prohibit it.

Key concerns include:

1. Residents can be ticketed for parking on properly constructed hard surfaces on their own property, even when it does not affect anyone else.
2. The by-law creates an unnecessary financial burden for families who already face limited parking options due to housing density and multi-generational living.
3. The new definition of "Unauthorized Area" goes beyond reasonable regulation and unfairly penalizes law-abiding residents. This by-law acts as a hidden tax, adding ticketing costs to residents already facing record-high property taxes and living expenses in Brampton
