

Issue Background:

We support road safety and responsible driving but by-law 078-2024

- 1) Prioritizes revenue generation over safety improvements;
- 2) Risks unfairly penalizing taxpayers with costly fines without addressing the root causes of unsafe driving;
- 3) Purposely places cameras/speed signs in an inconsistent manner to confuse drivers and increases the likelihood of tickets without really addressing true safety concerns;
- 4) Results in excessive fees and essentially is another hidden tax on taxpayers
- 5) Has no requirement for the city to disclose how much revenue is generated from tickets and how funds are used;
- 6) Penalizes taxpayers with a delayed ticket system where a person can get multiple tickets on the same camera without knowing about it in a timely manner and for speeds which are barely above the speed limit;
- 7) Privacy concerns
