Re: Howden Boulevard Safety and Cycling Improvements

The City of Brampton invites you to help shape the future of Howden Boulevard. We're seeking your feedback on proposed road safety and cycling improvements designed to make Howden Boulevard safer and more comfortable for everyone – whether you walk, bike, drive or take transit.

Earlier this year, Brampton City Council approved a new project to explore moving the bike lanes on Howden Boulevard (from the road onto the boulevard) between Williams Parkway and Central Park Drive. This project will:

- improve safety for people walking and cycling.
- assess how the changes may affect traffic flow.
- ensure bike lanes are safe and well-maintained year-round.
- collect input from the community before making any final decisions.

City staff has developed different design alternatives for integrating bike lanes along Howden Boulevard. Before we finalize the design, you are invited to share your comments and questions at the following public engagement sessions:
