**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

**OVERVIEW:**

- **This report seeks direction to rename the stormwater management pond Heliotrope Pond to Triveni Pond.**
- **The renaming of the pond would recognize the Brampton Triveni Mandir and its significant contributions to the community.**
- **Staff estimate the cost for the renaming will be approximately \$800; sufficient funding is available for this initiative in the Parks Maintenance & Forestry division operating budget.**

**BACKGROUND:**

At the April 20, 2022, City Council Meeting a request was presented to rename Heliotrope Pond to Triveni Pond.

The stormwater management pond is located at the major intersection of Chinguacousy Road and Daviselm Drive, near the Brampton Triveni Mandir in Ward 5. The Mandir, which opened in 2022, has become a vital part of the community, offering spiritual

guidance, volunteer opportunities and programs that support youth, seniors and residents.

### **CURRENT SITUATION:**

The renaming would recognize the Brampton Triveni Mandir and its significant contributions to the community, which include welcoming over 100,000 devotees annually, engaging 1,500 volunteers and supporting 640 students through a variety of religious, educational and recreational programs.

Upon the approval of the new asset name, staff will proceed with installing appropriate signage at the site.

### **CORPORATE IMPLICATIONS:**

#### **Financial Implications:**

Staff estimate the cost for the stormwater management pond identified for renaming, will cost approximately \$800. Sufficient funding is available for this initiative in the Parks Maintenance & Forestry division operating budget.
