RE: Motion Regarding Opposition to Credit Valley Conservation (CVC)  
Consolidation

Please be advised that Regional Council approved the following resolution at its meeting held on March 26, 2026:

**Resolution Number 2026-220**

Whereas Credit Valley Conservation (CVC) is a locally governed conservation authority established to manage the Credit River watershed and provide critical services including flood protection, watershed science, source water protection, and the management of publicly owned conservation lands; and

And whereas, watershed municipalities have invested significant municipal and taxpayer resources over many decades to build and maintain the lands, infrastructure, and programs delivered through CVC; and

And whereas, the Province of Ontario has announced its intention to consolidate conservation authorities, including the proposed amalgamation of CVC into a Western Lake Ontario Regional Conservation Authority; and

And whereas, municipalities within the Credit River watershed have not been adequately consulted on a proposal that would fundamentally change the governance and management of locally funded watershed services and conservation lands;

Therefore be it resolved:

1. That the Council of the Region of Peel formally opposes the proposed consolidation of Credit Valley Conservation into a Regional Conservation Authority; and
2. That Council calls on the Province of Ontario to leave the governance structure of Credit Valley Conservation unchanged; and
3. That at a minimum, the Province immediately pause the proposed consolidation of CVC into a regional conservation authority until full and meaningful consultation has occurred with watershed municipalities and mayors; and
4. That this resolution be forwarded to the Honourable Todd McCarthy, the Minister responsible for conservation authorities, the Premier of Ontario, local Members of Provincial Parliament, the Board of Credit Valley Conservation, and watershed municipalities within the Credit River watershed.
