

### Appendix C - Summary Chart of Municipal Alcohol Policy Changes

New Requirement/Issues as per <i>Liquor Licence Act (2019)</i>	Current Policy (2016)	Proposed Policy (2021)
<b>Cannabis legalization</b>	<i>Not previously included</i>	NEW – Policy statement added to restrict the sale, service or consumption of any cannabis products on City property including mixing with alcohol.
<b>Tailgate Parties/ Special Occasion Permits</b>	<i>Not previously included</i>	NEW – Policy statement added affirming that tailgate parties are prohibited on City property.
<b>Language requiring event organizers to follow the Policy and all accompanying guidelines</b>	<i>Not previously included</i>	NEW – Policy statement added requiring event organizers to follow all requirements in addition to the Policy in the form of the MAP Standards and Guidelines (MAPSG) document.
<b>Liability Insurance limit increase to \$5 million</b>	<i>Not previously included</i>	NEW – Policy statement added affirming event organizers must have sufficient liability insurance as per City criteria. \$5 million requirement updated and included in MAPSG.
<b>Alcohol serving/consumption hours</b>	<i>Not previously included</i>	NEW – Policy statement added affirming the City’s authority to regulate alcohol serving hours. Specific requirements not allowing alcohol to be served before 11AM included in MAPSG.
<b>Food no longer required to be served with alcohol</b>	Food to be served with alcohol	Food to continue to be served at alcohol events.
<b>Permit boundary changes no longer requiring physically separated alcohol serving areas</b>	Physical boundaries required	New policy statement requiring areas where alcohol is served or consumed to be physically separated (e.g. beer tents).
