

SENIOR'S HOUSING

Affordable and Healthy Living Options for Elders in our Communities who would benefit from culturally responsive services in their home.



SENIOR'S HOUSING OPTIONS:

- Affordable/Subsidized/Supportive also known as rent-gearedto-income (RGI), provides safe, well-maintained rental housing for seniors with low and moderate incomes. With culturally appropriate supports available on site.
- **Life Lease** provide older individuals and couples with a lifetime right to occupy a unit and have access to communal facilities and services with the assurance that they will have much in common with their neighbours.
- Rental/Retirement apartment buildings that are purpose built for seniors or over time have naturally attracted a large proportion of older tenants.





Proposed Concept

All scenarios propose at least a 160-unit building with the following bedroom mix and administration plus programming space, bringing the total building space to 125,000 ft²:

- > 100 one-bedroom units (Standard 600 Modified 625 ft² each)
- ➤ 60 two-bedroom units (Standard 700 Modified 750 ft² each)
- Market Standard estimating 84 Units
- Affordable estimating 36 Units

This scenario also includes a 10.000 ft² of community space within the building including office and programming space.






Brampton Housing Innovation

We along with our partners, submitted three applications to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care as part of their recent call for proposals to add 15,000 culturally appropriate LTC beds across the province.

- 128 beds dedicated to the South Asian community in 320 bed home

Brampton Application: Approved!

- Indus Community Services LTC Home
- 192 256 beds dedicated to South Asian community on a land to be procured

Oakville Application: Round 2 Review Stage Completed

- Indus Community Services LTC Home in partnership with Thrive Group & EllisDon
- 256 beds out of 512 dedicated to the South Asian community across from Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital

Milton Application: In Process...

- Primacare and Indus Community Services partnership
- 64-96 beds dedicated to the South Asian community in 256 bed home





EXTENDED SUPPORTS

Additional Culturally Responsive Supports to provide extra assistance to Individuals and Families when their Need is Greatest.



EXTENDED SUPPORTS

- **Dialysis and Other Medical Supports** could be provided on site to ensure resident and community supports are available in a culturally welcoming and professional space.
- **Respite care** offers temporary, substitute living arrangements for seniors in order to provide a brief period of relief or rest (usually more than twenty-four hours) for the family members, guardians or other people who are their regular caregivers.
- **Emergency housing for seniors (60+)** providing hospitable shelter space for homeless or atrisk seniors.
- **Palliative Care** is a special kind of health care for individuals and families who are living with a life-threatening illness, usually at an advanced stage.
