We would like to formally invite the City of Brampton to co-lead our roundtable on international students, co-hosted by Sheridan College. This roundtable is committed to improving the post-secondary experience of international students by identifying gaps and systemic barriers, as well as providing knowledge and guidance on inclusive policies and best practices. Our aim is to engage with stakeholders to understand the needs of international post-secondary students and contribute to the development of short, medium, and long-term goals that can ensure a successful experience for these students.
