6.1 Review Workplan and Timelines

At the request of the Chair, Peter Fay, City Clerk, provided an overview of the Sub-committee's Terms of Reference, highlighting the following objectives:

- To develop a well-constructed and clearly understood Procedure By-Law to facilitate the business of City Council
- To increase the effectiveness and efficiency of City Council and Committee Meetings
- To ensure the decision-making process is accountable, transparent and accessible to and understood by the public and stakeholders, and provides opportunities for participation and input
- To exercise and respect individual and collective roles and responsibilities during meetings

- To reflect legislative requirements
- To build upon municipal best practices that fit within the City's governance structure

In response to suggestions and questions from the Sub-committee, Mr. Fay confirmed that the review could include the use of pronouns in the existing by-law and a review of the process for reporting out from Closed Session.

Regional Councillor Palleschi, Sub-committee Chair, suggested that Members provide their comments and questions to the City Clerk for consideration at a future meeting, along with any comments or questions received from the public.

6.2 Review of Existing By-law and Discussion re. Review Issues and Opportunities

Peter Fay, City Clerk, outlined the four phase process for the Procedure By-law review, and explained that this section of the agenda is for an open conversation on individual comments, ideas, and priority areas of focus toward improvements to the by-law.

Mr. Fay noted that meetings will be scheduled with each Member of Council to seek their input on areas of concern and suggested amendments/improvements.

Committee consideration included:

- agreement that a wholesale review of the by-law is not required, but that improvements are needed
- suggestions for improvements to the consolidated version of the by-law, including making it more interactive, providing links to amending by-laws, amendments to pronouns used throughout the document
- need for a summary version of the by-law for quick reference purposes, with assistance from Strategic Communications
- potential for amendments to the by-law during this Term of Council, and suggested amendments for consideration during the next Term

- role of the meeting Chair as it relates to upholding procedures during meetings
- areas of concern:
 - o addition of new business items at the meetings
 - o potential overuse of Points of Order and Points of Personal Privilege
 - use of "points of clarification" and "points of information" which are not provided for in the by-law
 - comments, questions and Points of Order raised during the taking of a votes

During the Sub-committee's consideration, Mr. Fay responded to questions and clarified various sections of the by-law.

Discussion took place with respect to the schedule of meetings for the Subcommittee. It was suggested that Members review the Procedure By-law and provide their comments, questions, suggestions to Mr. Fay for consideration at the next Sub-committee meeting.
