**October 18, 2021:** Announced intention to introduce legislation that, if passed, would require temporary help agencies (THAs) and recruiters to have a licence to operate in the province.

**October 15, 2021:** In advance of October 22, the Ontario government is making the enhanced vaccine certificate with official QR code and the free, made-in Ontario verification app, Verify Ontario, available for download.

**October 15, 2021:** Launched a pilot program to help municipalities and landowners prepare industrial sites for investments that will drive regional growth and job creation.

**October 15, 2021:** Announced the swearing-in ceremony of the Cabinet will take place on October 26, 2021, and that Parliament will return on November 22, 2021.
