

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON



A by-law to authorize the use of voting and vote counting equipment for City of Brampton Municipal Elections, and to repeal By-law 68-2017

**WHEREAS** Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, permits the council of a municipality to pass a by-law authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators for the purposes of accessible voting and counting votes at municipal elections;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

- Vote tabulating equipment may be used for City of Brampton municipal elections at all voting locations on voting day and advance voting dates, in accordance with such procedures and forms as may be established by the City Clerk in conformance with the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, as amended;
- 2. Accessible voting machines may be used for City of Brampton municipal elections at designated voting locations on voting day and advance voting dates, in accordance with such procedures and forms as may be established by the City Clerk in conformance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*; and
- 3. That By-law 68-2017, a by-law to authorize the use of electronic vote tabulating equipment for City of Brampton Municipal Elections be repealed.
