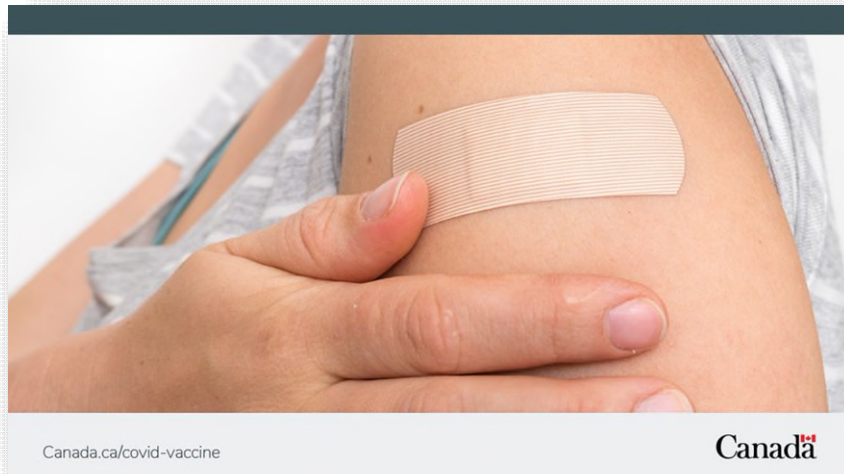
**November 10, 2021:** Announced pausing the lifting of capacity limits in remaining higher-risk settings as outlined in *A Plan to Safely Reopen Ontario and Manage COVID-19 for the Long-Term*.

**November 9, 2021:** Investing \$12.4M over two years to provide existing and expanded mental health and addictions supports for all frontline health care workers across the province.

**November 09, 2021:** Investing \$267.6M over three years through the province's *Community Safety and Policing (CSP) Grant program*.

- Additional \$42M through the provincial priorities funding stream for gun and gang related violence, sexual violence and harassment, human trafficking, mental health and addictions as well as hate-motivated crime.





**November 12, 2021:** Health Canada has authorized the use of the Moderna Spikevax COVID-19 vaccine as a booster shot.

**November 9, 2021:** Health Canada has authorized the use of the Pfizer-BioNTech Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine as a booster shot.
