To enact a Statutory Officials	By-law and repeal Municipal Officials By-law 84
	2008, as amended

WHEREAS By-law 84-2008 provides for the appointment of officials of The Corporation of the City of Brampton;

Whereas Council deems it appropriate to replace By-law 84-2008 with a new by-law to appoint certain statutory positions authorized or prescribed by the *Municipal Act, 2001*, and the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. (1) That David Barrick be and is appointed as Chief Administrative Officer (also known as City Manager) and shall exercise all powers and duties of the position for all purposes under the *Municipal Act*, 2001, City by-laws and policies.
 - (2) Where the Chief Administrative Officer is absent from his duties for any reason, a Department Commissioner or Head as designated in writing by the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to act in the place of the Chief Administrative Officer and shall exercise all the powers and duties as set out in subsection (1).
- (a) That Nash Damer be appointed as Treasurer and is hereby delegated all of the powers and duties of the Treasurer with respect to the collection of taxes.
 - (a) That Zeeshan Majid be appointed as Deputy Treasurer.
- 3. That Bill Boyes be appointed as Fire Chief;
- 4. (a) That Peter Fay be appointed as City Clerk, and
 - (b) That Charlotte Gravlev be appointed Deputy City Clerk, Council and Committee Operations, and
 - (c) That Janice Adshead be appointed Deputy City Clerk, Administrative Services and Information Management.
- 5. That By-law 84-2008, as may be amended, is hereby repealed.
