To provide for voter information  
to be translated into other  
languages for  
2022 City of Brampton  
Municipal Election

---

**WHEREAS** Section 9.1(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law allowing the use of languages other than English and French on information provided to voters;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton  
**ENACTS** as follows:

That voter information for the 2022 Municipal Election conducted under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, may be translated into those languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the population of the City of Brampton according to the most recent Census, plus French and Italian:

- a. French
- b. Punjabi
- c. Urdu
- d. Gujarati
- e. Tamil
- f. Hindi
- g. Spanish
- h. Portuguese
- i. Tagalog (Pilipino, Filipino)
- j. Vietnamese
- k. Italian
