Provincial Government







November 28, 2021: Confirmed two cases of the Omicron variant of COVID-19 in Ottawa, both of which were reported in individuals with recent travel from Nigeria.

November 25, 2021: The province will host a provincial-municipal housing summit on December 16 for Ontario's Big City mayors and regional chairs.

Aims to identify further opportunities for collaboration to address the housing affordability crisis.

November 24, 2021: Investing an additional \$90M over three (3) years to further promote the skilled trades to young people.

Includes additional \$2.9M, for a total of \$20M annually, to expand the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP).

November 23, 2021: Announced two capital building programs representing \$600M to fund 78 school and child care related projects.

Part of previously announced commitment to provide \$14B to support school construction over ten (10) years.

November 29, 2021: Launched the call for proposals for Parks Canada's National Cost-Sharing Program for Heritage Places.

November 26, 2021: Introduced legislation that would amend the *Canada Labour Code* to provide ten (10) days of paid sick leave per year to workers in the federally regulated private sector.

November 22, 2021: The Speech from the Throne opened the first session of the Forty-Fourth Parliament of Canada and outlined the minority government's priorities as it enters its third term on office. The government priorities include:

- COVID-19 pandemic response
- Resilient economy
- Climate action

November 19, 2021: Launched the 2021–22 Call for Proposals for community-based projects through the New Horizons for Seniors Program (NHSP).

The 2021–22 NHSP community-based Call for Proposals is open until December 21, 2021.
