The Region understands that the Town of Halton Hills has already expressed concerns that the action proposed in the ICBL report does not address how the actions being proposed address the MOU. That is, the ICBL report is silent as to how the City will continue to ensure that other components of the HPBATS MOU remain protected as they integrate into the GTA West Corridor.
