Our campus of care will include:

Project Status



- Offers to Lease signed with City.
- Ministry of Long-Term Care staff have confirmed all licensing requirements have been satisfied.
- CMHC has provided maximum SEED Funding to support planning and design of seniors apartment.

Status of Planning Approvals



- Preliminary concept plan drawings submitted to City Planning Department.
- Zoning is in place for project and site plan approval process underway (Pre-Consultation meeting Feb 1, 2022).
- Construction aimed for late 2022.

Financial Concerns



- Rise in construction costs largely due to pandemic-related supply chain disruption and shortages of labour and material.
- Pro forma budget shows a capital funding gap in excess of \$4.0 million.
- Without further funding support, project may be at risk and City may lose up to \$100 million in much needed long-term care beds and affordable housing supply.

City of Brampton Development Charges



- Development charges are significant contributors to project costs:
 - Affordable housing component: \$1,993,000
 - Long-term care component: \$1,131,000

City of Brampton Affordable Housing Strategy



- City of Brampton Affordable Housing Strategy (April 2021) recommends waiving municipal development charges in order to help meet affordable housing needs
- CMHC enhances housing grants when local municipality contributes to meeting project costs
- City of Brampton Central Area Community Improvement
 Plan provides for Development Charges Incentives for
 intensification of this nature. We border on the Central Area
 and are accomplishing important City goals and therefore
 should receive similar treatment
