Recommendations:

- That the report from Natalia Fleishman, Interim Supervisor, Parks Projects, dated January 16th, 2022 to Committee of Council meeting of February 16th, 2022, re: Request to Begin Procurement – Hiring of General Landscape Contractor for the Construction Improvements to Eldorado Park – Ward 4 be received, and
- 2. That the Purchasing Agent be authorized to commence the procurement for the Hiring of a General Landscape Contractor for Construction improvements to Eldorado Park.

Overview:

- This report seeks Council approval to commence the procurement to hire a General Landscape Contractor for construction improvements at Eldorado Park.
- The construction for Eldorado Park consists of infrastructure & landscape improvements to the existing park.

Background:

Eldorado Park and area is an existing mature wooded site dominated by deciduous floodplain forest, incorporating some wetland and upland deciduous forest along the Credit River, which divides the park. Eldorado Park is a heritage designated site and home to several species of plants, birds, fish, butterflies, and mammals; Eldorado has forest communities greater than 2 hectare in size and wetlands over 0.5 hectare in size. The existing Eldorado Park contains trails, a pavilion building, a small Parks Operation Building, a recently upgraded playground with swings, picnic areas and an existing pool.

The intent is to redevelop the existing park to include an exciting, bold, historically-themed splash pad, new comfort station, new parks maintenance building, picnic shelters, pollinator gardens, wetland & woodland restoration areas as well as major improvements to parking, roadways and pathways.

Current Situation:

Community Services, Parks Projects are prepared to proceed with procurement for the Hiring of a General Landscape Contractor for Construction improvements at Eldorado Park.

The Scope of the Project includes the installation of the following:

- A new historically themed splash pad
- A new parks maintenance building
- A new comfort station, housing change rooms, washrooms and a mechanical room
- Upgrades to the accessible all-inclusive playground
- Picnic shelters
- New parking areas and internal roadway
- Environmental restoration areas & bioswales
- Pollinator gardens
- New Pathway pedestrian connections
- Wayfinding signage

The scope of work will also include park grading, upgraded drainage, site furnishings with decorative features and landscaping, all in accordance with City of Brampton standards.

The new park elements are being built with the support and confirmation of Recreation and Parks Maintenance and Operations staff, who will operate and maintain the new park elements.
