BY-LAW

A by-law to provide for a special mail-in voting program for the 2022 City of Brampton Municipal Election, and to repeal By-law 266-2021

WHEREAS Section 42(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS Council has directed that a special mail-in voting program be provided as an alternative voting method for electors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

1. That the use of a special mail-in voting program be authorized for the 2022 Municipal Election.
2. Section 43 (advance vote) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, shall not apply to the alternative voting method contemplated in section 1 of this by-law.
3. Section 44 (voting proxies) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, shall not apply to the alternative voting method contemplated in section 1 of this by-law.
4. That By-law 266-2021, a by-law to provide for a home voting service during the advance voting period for the 2022 Brampton Municipal Election be repealed.
