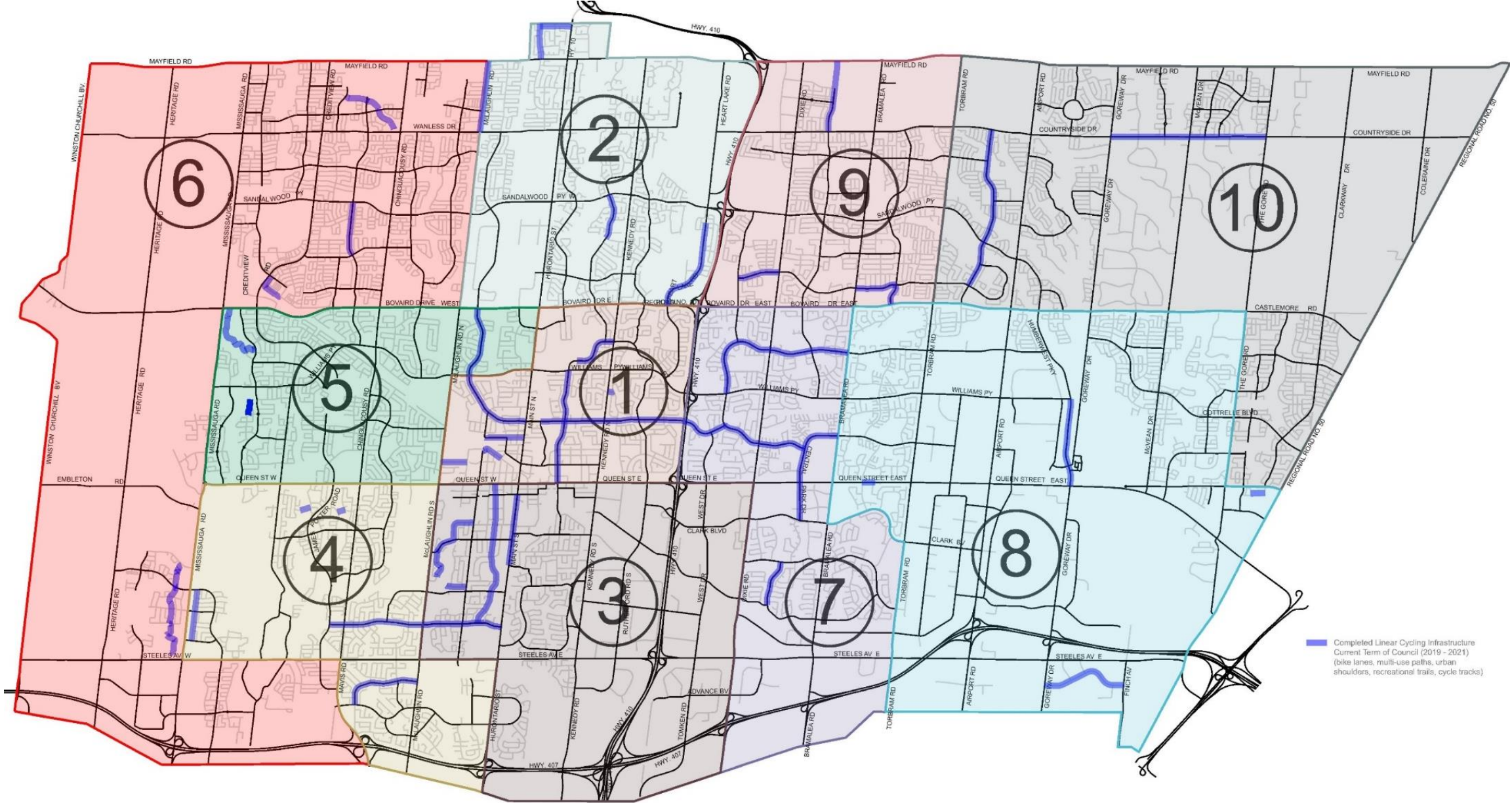

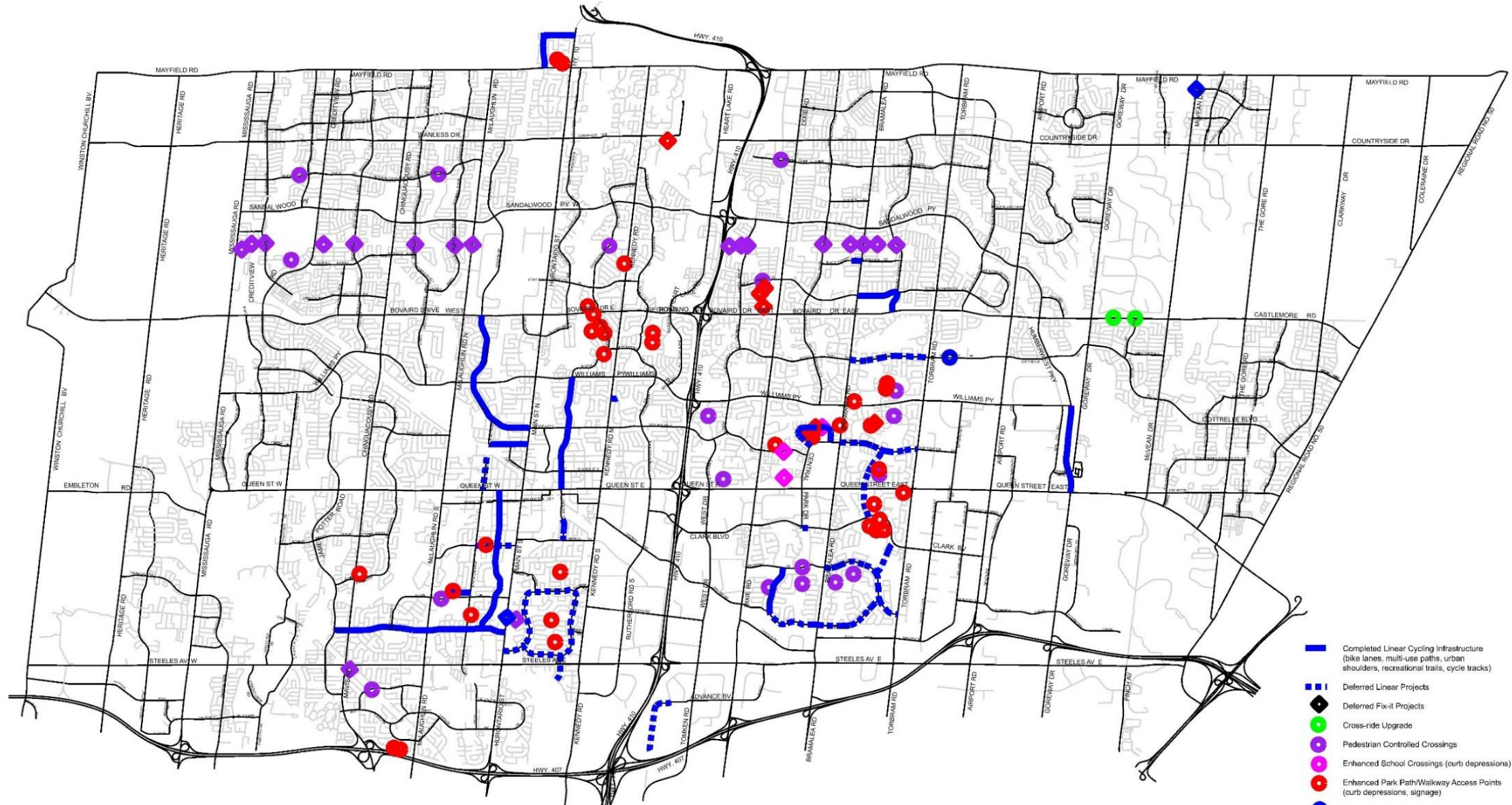

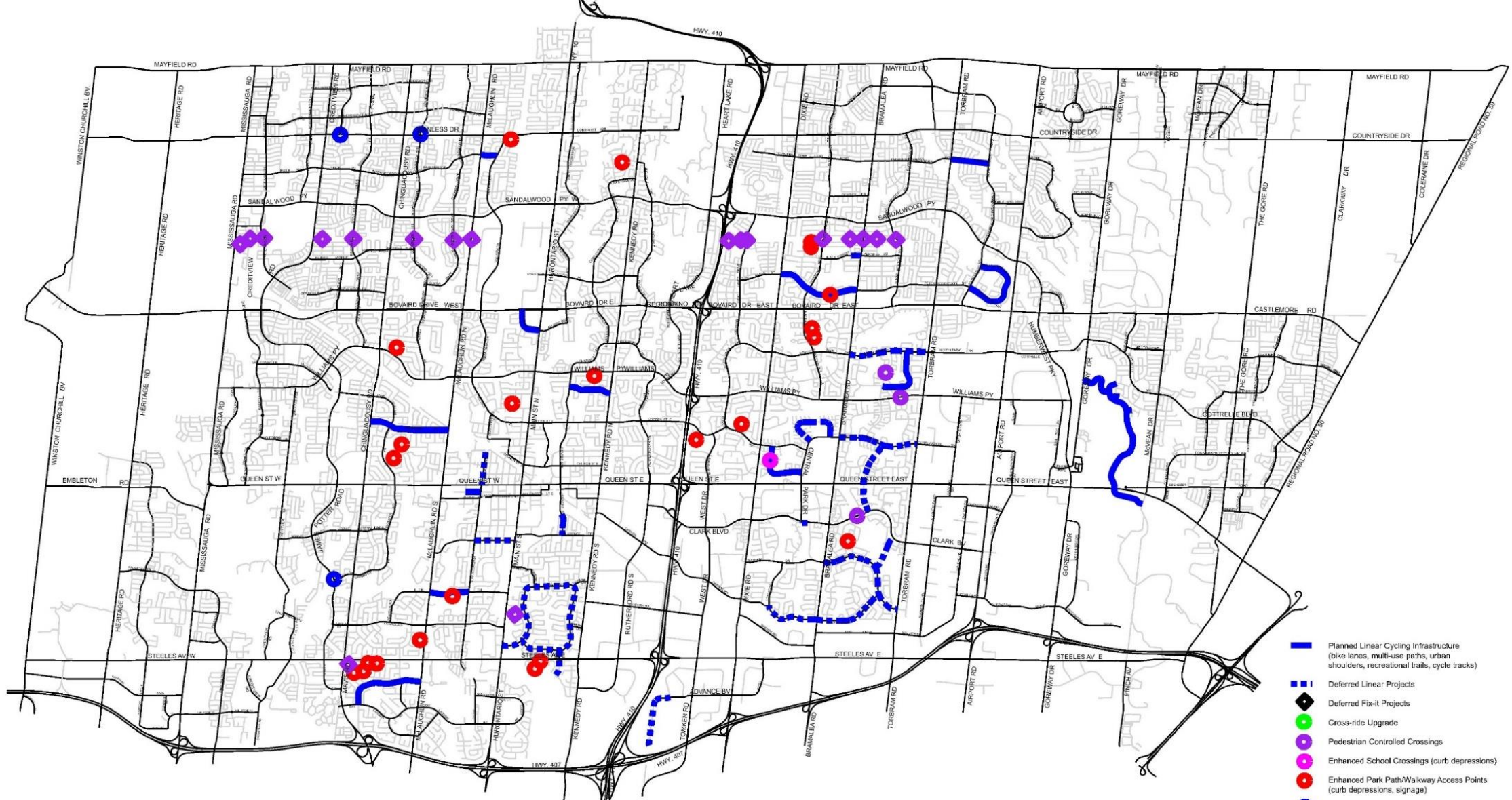


- 🚲 14.6 km of linear Infrastructure
