BY-LAW

To establish a Transfer Payment Agreement and By-law for Investing in Canada
Infrastructure Program – Public Transit Stream Funding

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario for funding under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Public Transit Stream;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton any Transfer Payment Agreements for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Public Transit Stream (“Agreement”) between Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, and The Corporation of the City of Brampton, under key business terms and conditions acceptable to the General Manager, Transit or designate, and in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor or designate.
2. THAT, the Mayor and City Clerk and, as applicable, the General Manager, Transit, are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton any amendments to the Agreement or ancillary documents necessary to fulfil the ICIP requirements, under key business terms and conditions acceptable to the General Manager, Transit or designate, and in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor or designate.
3. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk and, as applicable, the General Manager, Transit, have the delegation of authority to execute any and all required documentation, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as required under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program.
4. THAT the execution and delivery of any agreements, amendments or other documents authorized under this by-law may be done by electronic means.
5. THAT The Corporation of the City of Brampton commits to spending Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program funding in accordance with all of the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement.
6. THAT The Corporation of the City of Brampton commits to spending Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program funding only on implementing the approved projects identified in the Agreement.
