

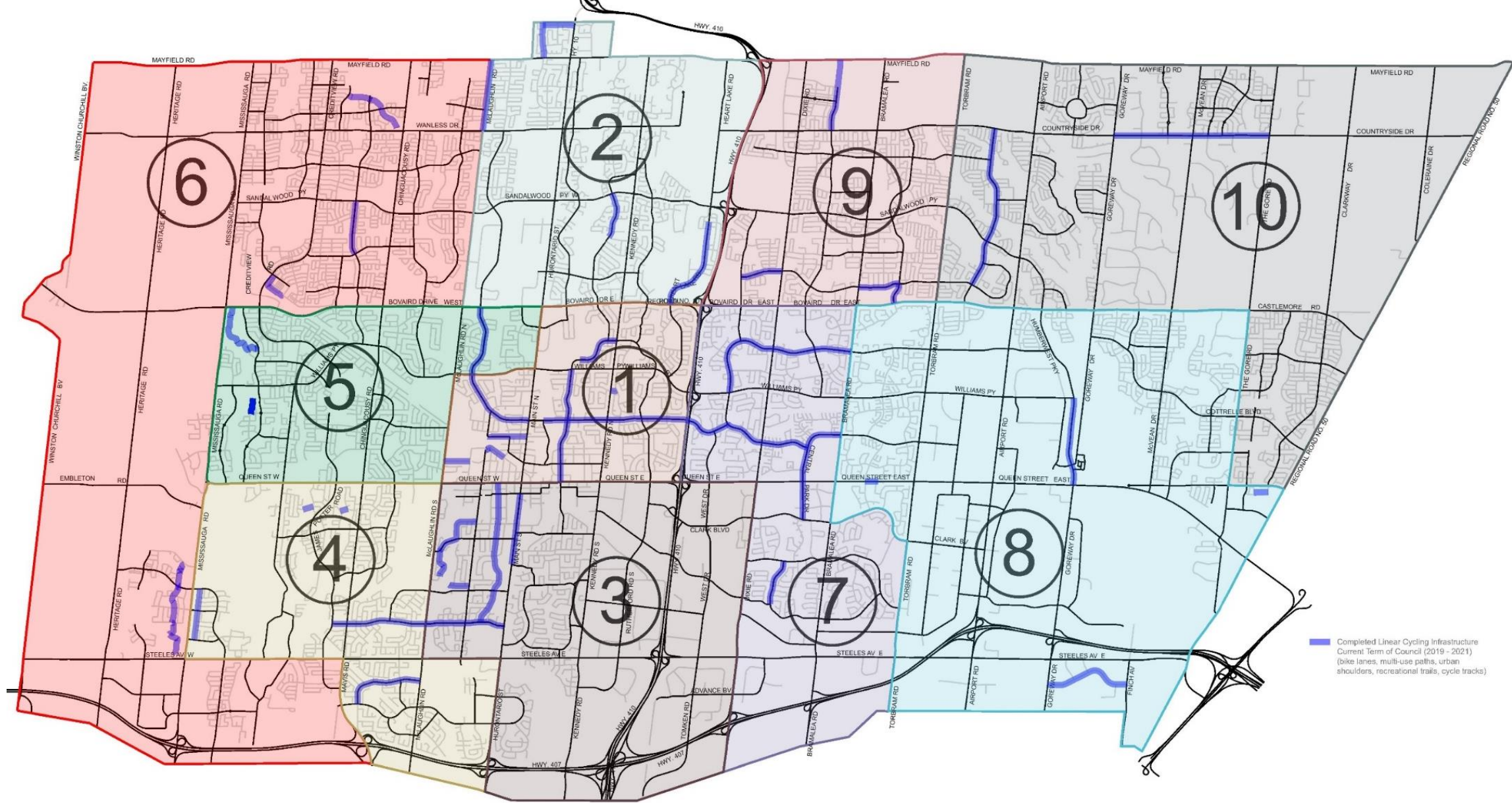

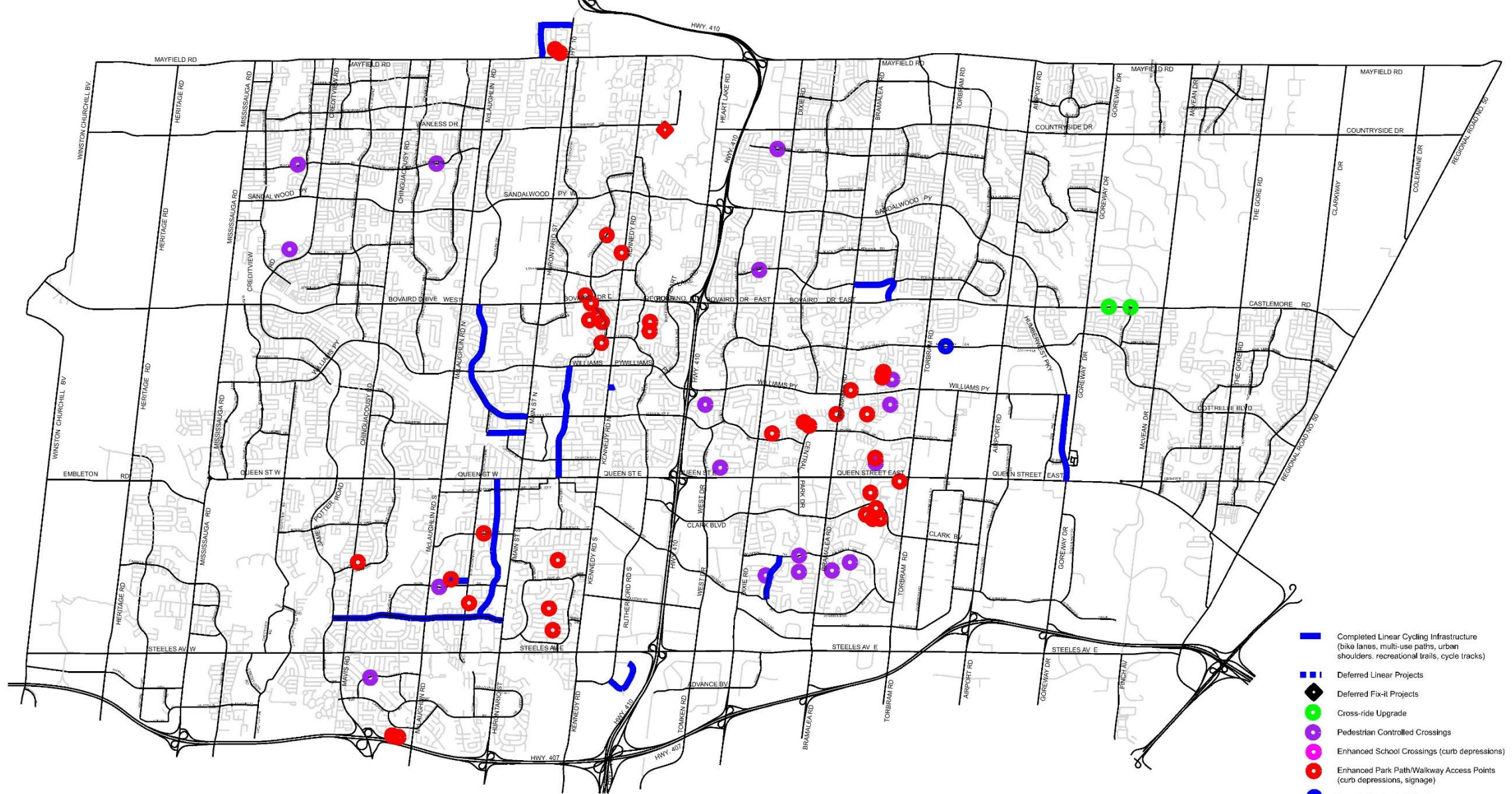

- 🚲 1 new traffic control signal



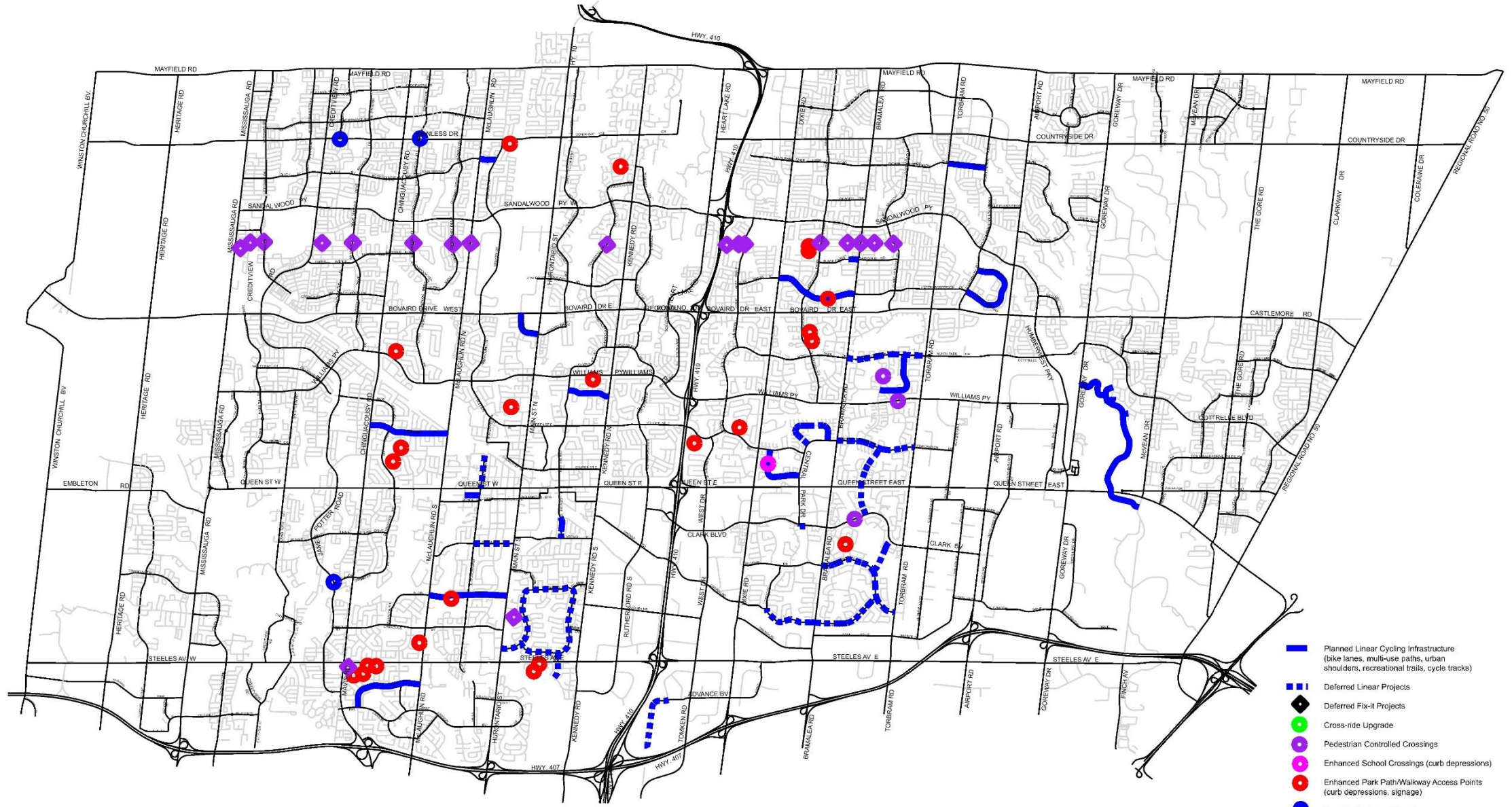
