- Subcommittee recommends City purchase a BASIC level RidewithGPS account so Leaders can have voice navigation and lead confidently without the distraction of looking at written notes. \$6US/month or \$50US/year
- Lisa/Barry have verified two people can be signed into one paid account and use voice navigation at the same time

- New volunteers: start as sweeper, then marshall, then leader
