Statistics of women/male victims!

- In the year 2020, Peel Police reported that the highest number of incidents are family and intimate partner violence related. In addition, it was reported that there were about 6 intimate partner homicide in Peel Region. (peelregion.ca)
- Let go back to the year 2019, Statistic Canada, as reported, female victims are higher in cases compared to male victims, which is based on intimate partner violence including deaths, sexual and physical assault.
- Female victims total:16 (homicide causing deaths and attempted murder)about 2,138 sexual assaulted, and 14,533 physical assaulted.
- Male victims total: 5 (homicide causing deaths and attempted murder) 51 sexual assaulted, and 2966 physical assaulted.





Cases of Victims in Peel...

- RECENTLY- January 21, 2022- women & men both shot in car outside Brampton home- still being investigated, reports says the gunshot of the male was self inflicted, the women did not survive.
- June 3rd, 2021- Dalbir Randhawa- killed by her spouse in Brampton park.
- August 13, 2020- Darian Hailey Henderson-Bellman- killed by her boyfriend in a Brampton home.
- December 9th, 2019-Sharanjeet Kaur body was found in the Brampton home, killed by Navdeep Singh before ending his own life.
- January, 12th, 2018- Baljit Thandi and her mother age 60- stab to death by Thandi spouse, in Brampton home.



How can WCP Shelter Help?

- We will work with Peel Police, other shelters, hospitals in the Region of Peel, to make awareness of our availability and space for welcoming each women and children, who need to flee situations of abuse/violence.
- Partnership with Taxi transport services for emergency transport to our shelter.
- Partnership with domestic hotline in the GTA & Peel.
- We will provide a “safe-haven” for as many women & children as possible.



Our team...

- We will have a team of professional who will provide counseling services, legal services, immigration consultation (if needed), housing support, ECE worker, youth worker, parenting & basic life skills , and volunteer staff for the both women and children.
