Re: Opposition to Budget Amendment Item 10.5.1

Since November 2021, Mayor Brown, all Brampton Councillors and many members of city staff have been aware of our 'Brampton Development Group's' proposal to develop the CAA lands with a world class Cricket facility as the focal point.

Our group will be presenting an overview of this proposal to Council and for public consumption next Wednesday June 8th, 2022.
