Dear Mayor and Members of Council,

In the June 2nd provincial election, the present City Councillor for Ward 7 & 8, Charmaine Williams was elected a Member of Provincial Parliament for Brampton Center. As there is less than 5 months remaining in this term of office, the Municipal Act requires Council to first declare the seat vacant and then determine a process to appoint a qualified individual to serve until the end of the remaining term of office.

Having served on Council for 30 years, representing Ward 7 & 8, I have been asked by members of Brampton City Council and by members of the public, if I would be willing to put my name forward for the interim appointment, in the best interest of the City.
